DAYTIME

Book Club III (Page Turners) – NEW. This group is for book lovers who want to meet during the day. This book club is limited to 12-15 members. Members take turns hosting book discussions and providing refreshments. Meets at 10:30am the first Friday of each month.

Bridge Round Robin – Coordinator: Nancy Ganci. Currently, there are 14 women playing in seven teams. Teams play one another monthly in an assigned rotation but are free to decide when and where they would like to meet. Playing levels of participants range from beginners to advanced. No substitute players are used for this group, but it is possible for an additional team to join no later than October and make up play for the month of September. Cost \$20 per person for the year. At present, there is an opening for 2 members.

Ladies Bunko I – NEW. Meets at 10am on the 2nd Thursday of each month. Members take turns hosting the group in their home and providing refreshments. Each member brings \$5 for the prize kitty each month.

Euchre Ladies– Coordinator: Dianne Baker. A trick taking card game with a trump, played by four players in teams of two. Meets on the 1st Thursday of each month. Members takes turns hosting in their homes.

Forest Creek Trekkers – Coordinator: Martha Wallace. Meets one or two weekend mornings a month, for group walks or hikes of 3-10 miles or cycling the trails around the neighborhood (10-12 miles). Scheduled for the 3rd Saturday of every month. Open to new members.

Garden Club Sow Beautiful – NEW. Members range from plant admirers to certified master gardeners – all levels of interest and experience. Activities may include excursions, speakers on seasonal plantings, garden tours (The Plano Garden Club hosts a Garden Tour every two years that is open to the public. The next tour is scheduled for the spring of 2024), etc. Meets at 9:30 am on the 1st Wednesday of the months of October, January, and April. Meeting homes or locations to be determined.

Golf – Coordinator: Beverly Dorney. Meet new golfing women. This group is to help facilitate golf games for women who want to get out and play but may not know or have anyone to play with.

Book Club (YaYa's) – Coordinator: Marion Bize. Meets monthly on the 1st Thursday evening at 7pm. Open to all members of FCWC. Members take turns hosting book discussions and providing refreshments in their home. While we do discuss plot, characters, style, theme, etc., this group is as social as it is literary. Feel free to join any of the meetings whether you have read the book.

Bunko V Couples – NEW. Couples bunko consists of 4-6 couples to allow 2-3 tables of 4 players. Subs are welcome. This group meets at 7pm on the 1st Saturday of each month for dinner and bunko. It's a fun dice game that requires no skill - just luck. Members take turns hosting in their home and provide a light meal (sandwiches, pizza, etc.), table snacks, and dessert. Drinks are BYOB. The group visits, eats, and then play begins with the roll of dice. It's a wonderful way of turning neighbors into friends! Each member brings \$5 for the prize kitty each month.
